**TWO FERRIES ADDED FOR**  
**SEPT. 18<sup>TH</sup> EDITION OF**  
**HUDSON FERRY-GO-ROUND**

*7,100 riders participated in August event*

**VALHALLA, N.Y.** (Aug. 30) – With a large turnout expected, two additional ferries have been added to the Sept. 18<sup>th</sup> reprise of the Hudson Ferry-Go-Round.

According to New York Waterway, the ferry-service provider for the event, more than 7,100 riders participated in the first leg of the 2005 Hudson Ferry-Go-Round on Saturday, Aug. 6<sup>th</sup>. With even larger crowds expected for the Sept. 18<sup>th</sup> running, organizers have added two ferries, expanding the fleet to six boats. Each ferry can transport 149 passengers.

The Sept. 18<sup>th</sup> Hudson Ferry-Go-Round will feature continuous ferries linking the villages of Haverstraw, Tarrytown, Ossining and Peekskill from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. Each river town will host special events for ferry riders to enjoy.

“The goal of this event is to draw more people to the magnificent Hudson River and promote the river as a vibrant transportation lane,” said Martin Ginsburg, the principal of GDC and the creator of the event. “We expect a huge turnout for the Sept. 18<sup>th</sup> event so we’ve added two ferries to accommodate more riders and shorten the lines of people waiting to board. There is no comparable event like this in the Hudson Valley.”
