HUDSON RIVER SCULPTURE TRAIL SEEKS PROPOSALS
FOR NEW ARTWORKS FROM ROCKLAND COUNTY ARTISTS

Ginsburg Development seeks ideas for new sculptures to display in Haverstraw

VALHALLA, N.Y. (Oct. 30) – A call for proposals for new artworks to be included in the Hudson River Sculpture Trail was announced during a celebration marking the opening of the trail in Haverstraw, N.Y., on Sept. 30.

Artists from Rockland County are being urged to submit proposals for new artworks to be included in future incarnations of the Sculpture Trail, which is expected to have a series of artworks on temporary display.
